**Parish Radio - 108FM:** Masses will continue to be broadcast on 108FM **without a congregation**. Mass will be broadcast on the parish radio each Sunday at 11am until the Sunday Masses can resume again. Mid-week Masses will also be broadcast at the usual times (see the Mass schedule). People are encouraged to stay connected with the parish and make use of this wonderful facility at this difficult time.

**Rosary:** Fr Sean will recite the **Rosary each evening at 9pm** and it will be broadcast on FM108.

**Coronavirus:** Msgr Liam Kelly has announced that all public Masses, except Funeral Masses, are suspended in the diocese of Kilmore until further notice.

- Churches will remain open for people to visit and pray.
- Spiritual communion is encouraged by participation in Mass and other liturgies by radio, television, webcam etc.
- Pope John Paul II called the Family Home 'The Domestic Church'. And that is what it is. Daily family prayer is encouraged.
- Eucharistic adoration will continue in churches. People are advised to follow the social distancing guidelines.
- That baptisms, weddings and funerals continue in our parishes and that the numbers present in our churches for these celebrations do not exceed 100
- In the current emergency situation, all are dispensed from the obligation to physically attend Sunday Mass.

**Radio Maria Ireland** is a Catholic station and can be found on television – Saorview, Channel 210 or on the internet. Daily Mass will be aired at 10am each day from their studio chapel, including Sundays for those who would like to tune in.

**SeniorLine** has been the national, confidential listening service for older people.
