Feast of the Immaculate Conception: Tuesday is the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Please see Mass times for your local church.

First Holy Communion: The First Communion Candidates in Bawnboy N.S. and Currin N.S. were disappointed twice this year with the postponement of their First Holy Communion. Thankfully, restrictions have eased so they can receive their First Holy Communion before Christmas. The ceremony will take place in Bawnboy on Saturday next at 12noon and then in Kilnavart on Saturday 19th December at 11am. Unfortunately, the number of people who can attend these ceremonies will be limited but the ceremony in Bawnboy will be streamed live on www.churchTV.ie/bawnboy. and on Facebook and broadcast on FM108 so that people can feel part of the celebration. Families are asked to follow the guidelines set out by the government. ie. Face Coverings are recommended and people are asked not to congregate before or after Mass.

Guided Holy Hour: will take place on each Tuesday night at 9pm in Bawnboy Church during this time of pandemic. The Holy Hour will consist of the Rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, Night Prayer and other reflective prayers. The Holy Hour will be broadcast on FM108 and live-streamed on www.churchTV.ie/bawnboy and the Parish Facebook page. People can now attend in person.

First Friday Visitations: Fr Sean will call to the sick and housebound after the 18th of December if that is their wish.
